Camp Agape Bereavement Camp for Children was conceived in 1994 to create a healing place for hurting hearts but it was not until 1999 that camp was established. Based on a "Walk To Emmaus" spiritual retreat weekend the name "Camp Agape" was born—inspired by an arched rainbow, over connecting figures of children, and the number twelve. In May of 2000, the IRS recognized our program as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, and in 2002 we held our first camp

program with just six children in attendance. It was held at the Buckner Boys' Ranch Orphanage in Burnet, TX. This year marks over a thousand children served since the inaugural camp in 2000. Thank you to those who have contributed to the Camp Agape ministry so far. We couldn't have reached these children without you.


