

Who conducts the Footprints program?

Footprints is a program offered through Camp Agape, a 501(c)(3), Non-Profit Organization that supports children and families who have suffered the loss of a loved one.

The Footprints Team leads, trains, and equips volunteers facilitators to fulfill roles within the program.

Who can volunteer to work with Footprints?

The Footprints Program needs volunteers at many levels and with diverse skill sets. Roles will include working directly with children, arts & crafts, administration, promotion, fundraising, communication, and more.

All volunteers will be screened, interviewed, and trained. In addition, background checks are conducted on all volunteers.

What is Footprints?

The Footprints Program is a community-wide program serving children and their families who are experiencing grief and loss.

We provide a safe, caring environment where children can learn to identify and cope with emotions. Most importantly, our goal is for children to complete the program, understanding "I am not alone in my grief." They see that others are experiencing the same kind of grief and the same emotions.



Mission Statement

Our mission is to serve children dealing with grief in a faith-based environment that is safe and accepting of all emotions - and to help the child understand and begin to deal with the emotions regarding their loss.

What does it cost?

Provided Free of Charge. No child or parent is charged for attending sessions.

Who is Footprints for?

Children ages 6-10, and 11-15, who are experiencing grief as a result of a loss due to the death of a loved one. Footprints provides an environment where grieving children can express what they feel and learn that they are not alone in dealing with the tough circumstances life sometimes brings.

Is Footprints an appropriate program for my children?

The program effectively places children in a peer support group with other children their age who have experienced loss. During the registration process, children are screened to help identify any need for professional assistance beyond what Footprints provides. In these cases, the family is referred to appropriate care.

When and where are Footprints classes held?

The Footprints Program is typically provided at a local community center, scheduled on an as-needed basis. The program is one hour a day, once weekly, for six (6) to eight (8) weeks.

How are the Footprints classes conducted?

All activities and sessions will be conducted in a group format led by three trained, non-related adult volunteers, with 6 to 8 children per group. All staff volunteers and facilitators are trained in the specifics of the activities and how to work with grieving children.

Activities and games are designed to help children understand their emotions and begin to process them. All activities and games are group-based, emphasizing the theme, "You are not alone".

While the children's sessions are conducted, parents/guardians attend a session of their own, where they are briefed on what to expect from the children following their session.

Getting the parents involved in the healing process is crucial to the child's success.
