Walk alongside a child in a fun, energetic camp setting and gain more confidence in sharing your story of grief. In this companion role, Buddies do everything their camper does!







How I was touched by

Summer Camp

Summer Camp 2022 was my first experience with Camp Agape. I was recruited to serve as a Grief Coach by the new Camp Director, Alaina Sivells, my daughter. Part of the recruitment process included a phone interview with the 2022 Lead Grief Coach, Ms. Betty. I was driving through the Hill Country one morning when I received the phone call for the interview, so I pulled over and settled in for what I thought would be a five-minute conversation. Instead, I was introduced to Camp Agape's heart in a 50-minute counseling session. My wife and I were coming out of a "season of loss" that had left us both struggling to cope with the volume and depth of the friends and family members who were no longer in our lives. Yet, the compassion of Christ and the love of God flowed through that call, and healing followed.

I moved into the role of Grief Coach at Summer Camp. One of the biggest blessings of serving at camp last summer was and will always will be unique to me. While my daughter was excited that she would be my boss for five days, I would have been way more excited if I had known I would have a front-row seat as she stepped into the ministry role God had created for her. Within 24 hours after the campers arrived, it was obvious to everyone that Alaina had found whom God meant for her to be. It was especially rewarding for me to get to witness this personally, as her father. Members of the Board of Directors came to me sharing, "We have to find some way to ensure we can get her to return. She is perfect for this." What they didn't know was that at the same time, Alaina was telling me that she would always be a part of Camp Agape. I can't begin to express what a blessing it was for me to be an eyewitness as my daughter and Camp Agape came together.
