Group sessions incorporate the use of art, music, games and equine therapy in a fun and nurturing summer camp setting.

Each child is matched with a "Buddy" who will assist the camper in all activities so they are never alone in the grief process.

This faith-based therapeutic program provides a sense of hope in their time of loss, blended with all the fun of a typical summer camp.
